WHAT IS THE ROUNDUP?

The RMI Roundup provides an opportunity for businesses, destinations and attractions within the region to meet face-to-face with targeted tour operators from Europe who specifically want to do business in Montana, North Dakota, South Dakota, and Wyoming. It is a low-cost and highly efficient way for local suppliers to meet with international tour operators and a small number of US-based receptive operators.

Registration must include payment and must be confirmed by the RMI office in Cheyenne to be considered valid. If you do not receive confirmation, please contact RMI to make sure your registration was received. Spaces will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. If all spaces are filled in one marketplace, suppliers will be given the opportunity to book a spot in the other marketplace. All participants must register in advance. Registration fees are non-refundable. A maximum of two participants per company may attend. (*Registration includes two people, adding guests could incur an additional charge*)

- name badge and registration materials
- extensive briefing and orientation
- breakfast and lunch on the marketplace day
- dinner with the tour operators
- opportunities to meet with all tour operators and receptives during the marketplace

How does it work?

The Roundup consists of a supplier briefing, a marketplace between buyers and sellers (suppliers), lunch and reception/dinner. At each marketplace tour operators will be located at specific tables and suppliers will circulate on a schedule of assigned appointment times, to each table, to meet with every tour operator and receptive.

Both marketplaces are identical in terms of tour operators present and you may choose to register for either one. Marketplaces will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis. Participation may be limited due to space constraints and registration may fillup fast before the deadline.

WHAT KIND OF TOUR OPERATORS WILL BE THERE?

International tour operators who specialize in selling the Real America region are invited to attend Roundup, to enhance their product base and knowledge of the region. Most operators are small to medium size companies who specialize in tailor-made fly and drive itineraries for individual clients. These operators provide their clients with unique experiences customized to needs and wants of each client.

Approximately 35 tour operators are invited via our RMI overseas offices in London, Munich, Amsterdam, Paris, Milan, and Sydney. In addition, RMI staff and state tourism representatives will participate in each marketplace as well as US-based receptive operators and a representative from the Real America Guide.

MATERIALS

Suppliers are encouraged to distribute thumb drives containing their information directly to operators instead of bulky printed materials which take up too much space and weight in luggage. It is important that you have commissionable or net rates (for lodging businesses) in place for at least a year in advance. If you need assistance with commissionable rates, please contact your state representative or RMI. You are welcome to show images and information on your laptop.

Registrants will receive detailed background information about the tour operators, along with pertinent information on what the operators are specifically looking for during the Roundup. Tour operators will receive information about registered suppliers as well.

ACCOMMODATIONS

The Holiday Inn Cody at Buffalo Bill Village and the Comfort Inn are both offering an event rate of \$128.52 including tax for single or double occupancy (up to 4 people) hotel rooms. Buffalo Bill Village Resort is offering a rate of \$106.92 (up to 4 ppl.) All 3 hotels are on the same property and include free shuttle service to and from the airport. Breakfast is included for Marketplace participants on your Marketplace day.
